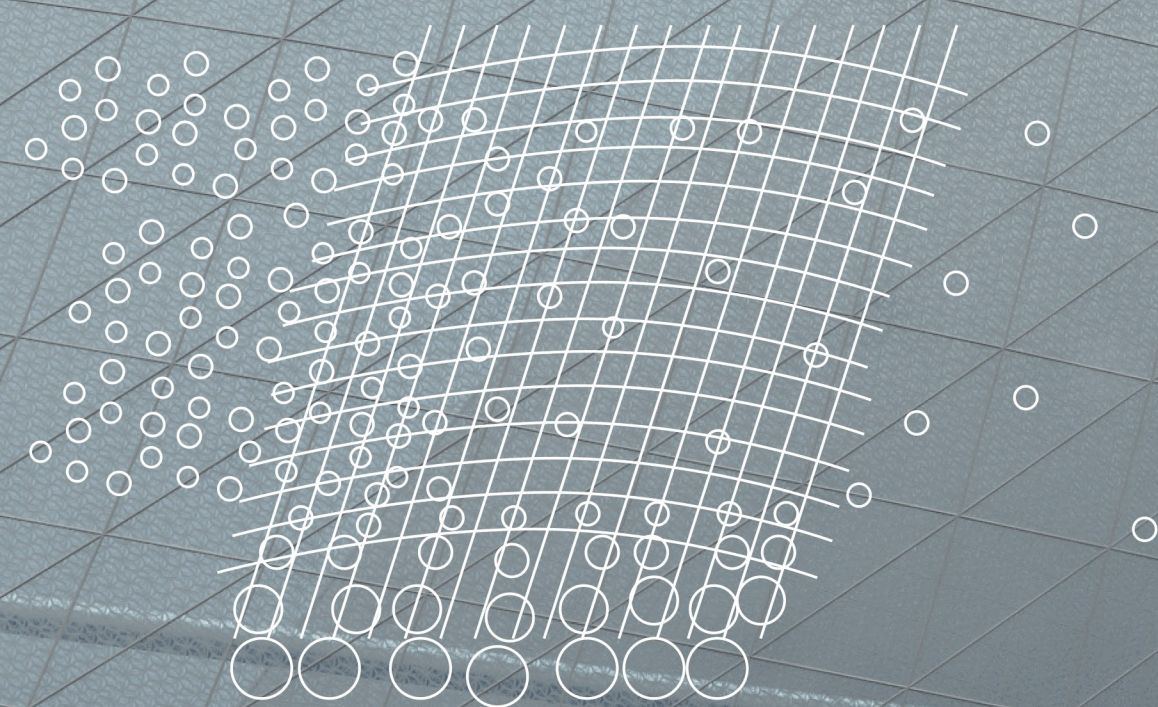


# regattaH<sub>2</sub>O

In this capacity, regattaH<sub>2</sub>O re-purposes this familiar maritime form as infrastructure which harvests fog to create fresh water and taps the wind to power its operations, all while conjuring the sweeping beauty and timeless qualities of these angular shapes.
