concept

- 1] Processing of water inspired by the natural cycle of water.
- 2] Form inspired by geology [Amplitude of water and waves]

An open-air pavilion comprising a landform plane that makes apparent the passive desalination process that contributes to the water supply of Santa Monica. Geology becomes a design generator for responsive architecture with references to landscape.

Natural tectonic is achieved through the **reconstruction** of nature, both in terms of form as well as experimentation with passive processing of water. This is achieved by folding and **surface manipulation**, creating **artificial terrains** housing desalination pods that simultaneously become places of leisure, education and contemplation.
