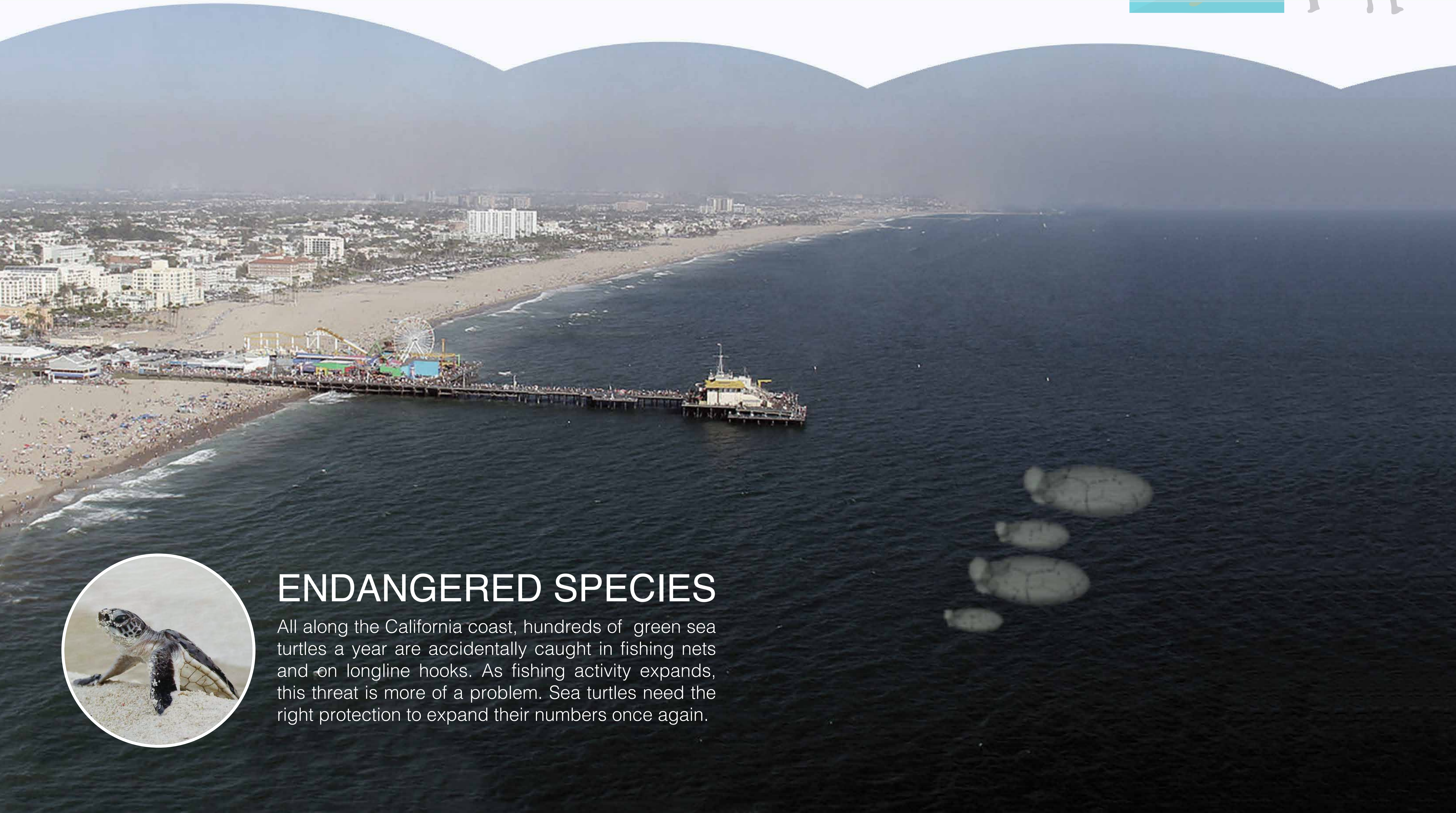
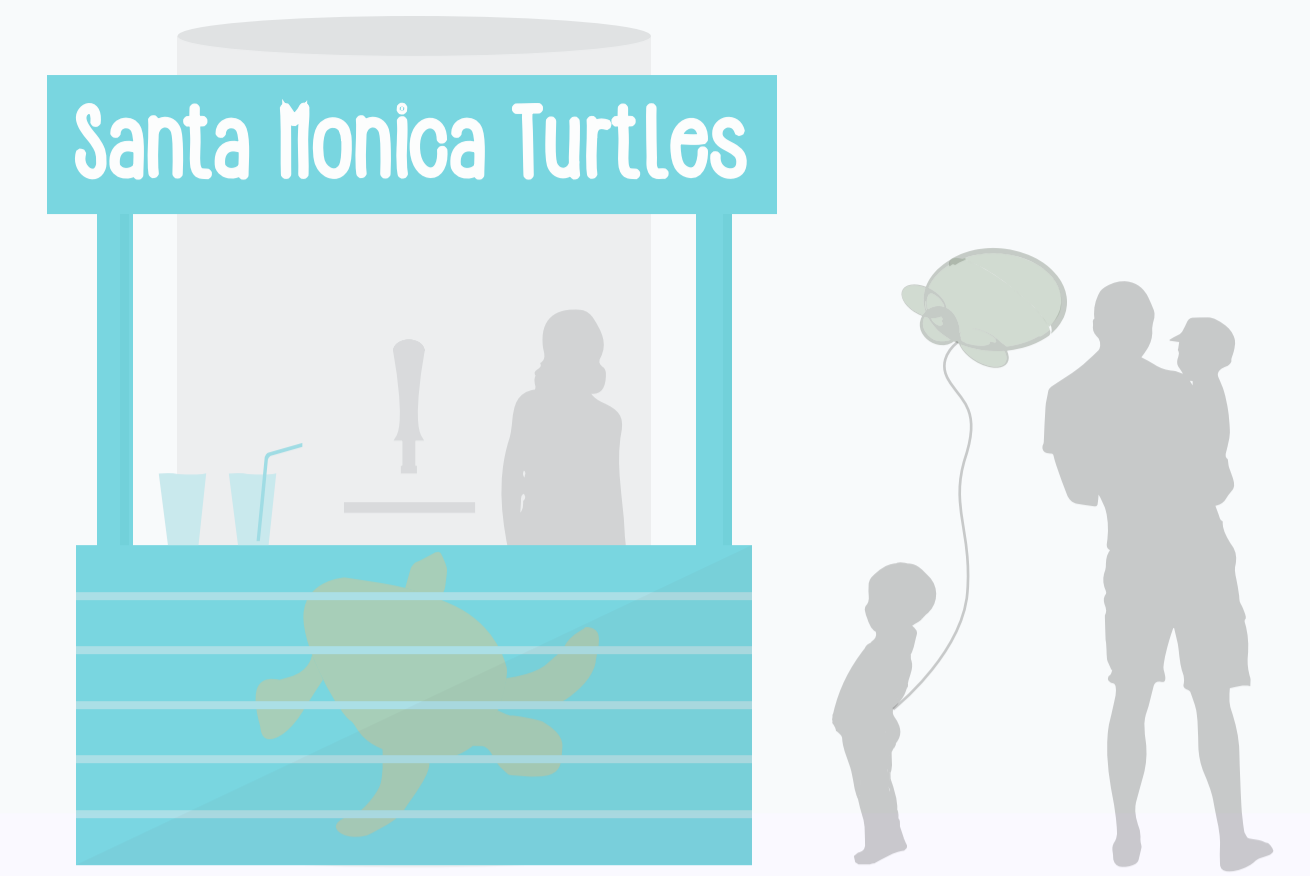
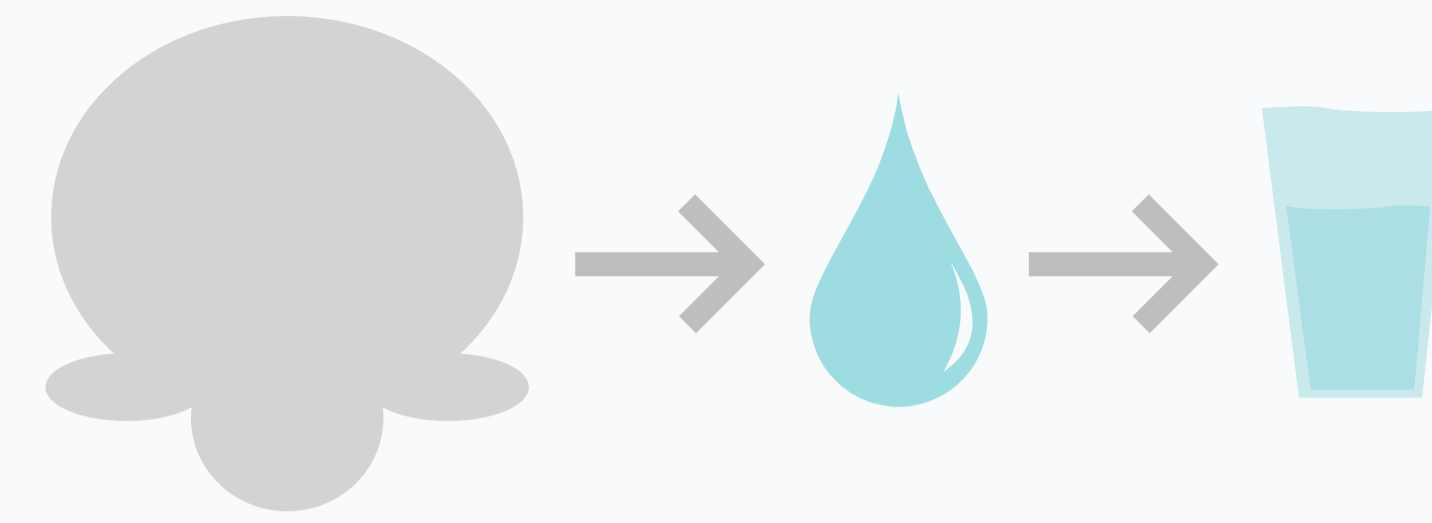


SHARING WITH SANTA MONICA
