

THE DESIGN WORKS IN TWO PARTS: AN ENERGY-PRODUCING ART INSTALLATION AND AN UNDERWATER VIEWING DECK THAT DOUBLES AS AN ODE TO SUSTAINABLE LIVING.

THE VIEWING DECK IS MADE ACCESSIBLE BY AN ADA COMPLIANT RAMP THAT ACTS AS A CONTINUATION OF THE SANTA MONICA PIER.

THE WOOD CONSTRUCTION SHIFTS TO STEEL 3' ABOVE THE HIGH-TIDE WATER LINE. AT THIS POINT THE GLASS RAILING BEGINS TO RISE AND RECEIVES A GLASS TOP FOR PROTECTION.

PANELS THAT WORK TO PRODUCE ENERGY ARE SCATTERED THROUGHOUT THE FAR STRETCH OF THE SITE. THEY CAN BE SEEN UNDER WATER FROM THE VIEWING DECK. SOME EXTEND OUT OF THE WATER AND CAN BE SEEN BY THOSE VISITING THE PIER.
