
Nowadays people are bombarded with information, incentives, at the same time – with shortening focus span. Most

As we observe the Universe, by just seeing its surface, also in this particular case we can just watch the outer layer of the building -but only by entering the inside we can experience its exact mechanism. Besides its visual aspects, it was also assigned other functions to engage in the users. We can walk inside, associate with the nature (hanging gardens). The spiral ramps can serve a purpose of space for some temporary science and art exhibitions. We can sit, think, write, read or sketch. It's an open and easily accessible for everyone public space. Place made for contemplation, creation, interaction, synergy -a crucible. Even simplifying - a box, into which we can throw anything. Approaching higher levels we, as in a symbolic way, are entering higher stages and going beyond -following & accessing the perfection. The culmination, crowning of our journey is a panorama view from the open terrace placed on the roof.

Very often in architecture and art we are using archetypes. We search for the simplest form, which we can easily identify, relate to. The main idea was to create an abstract form, simplest as it's possible, on the one hand very easy to understand, strong (Platonic solids), on the other hand ephemeral and interesting. The most popular solid is a cube, but in this case it wasn't a good fit -it's too heavy and dominant. Also it would cover what is the greatest strength of the site -a view on the horizon, immensity of the ocean. We wanted to create a disappearing, mimetic object, which was achieved by designing facades covered with one way glass. New element stands at the end, along the viewing axis of the Colorado Ave, fitting into the regular urban grid of the city. Standing on the pier, we can watch the narrow façade of the building. Its width follows the function of the object, at the same time being the same width as Colorado Ave is. New element has an oblong shape which makes it streamline. The height doesn't exceed 80m (2 ferry wheel heights).
