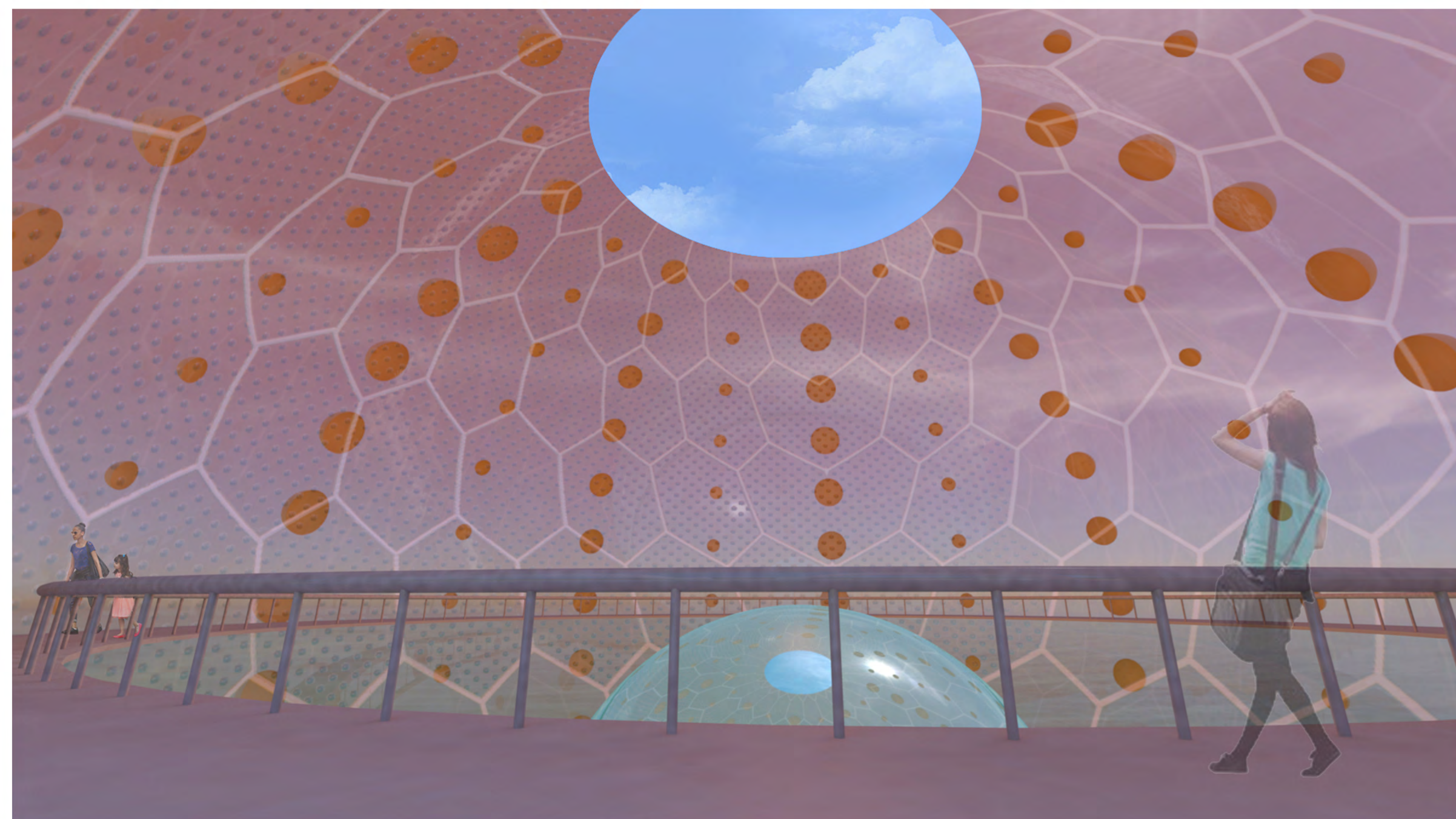


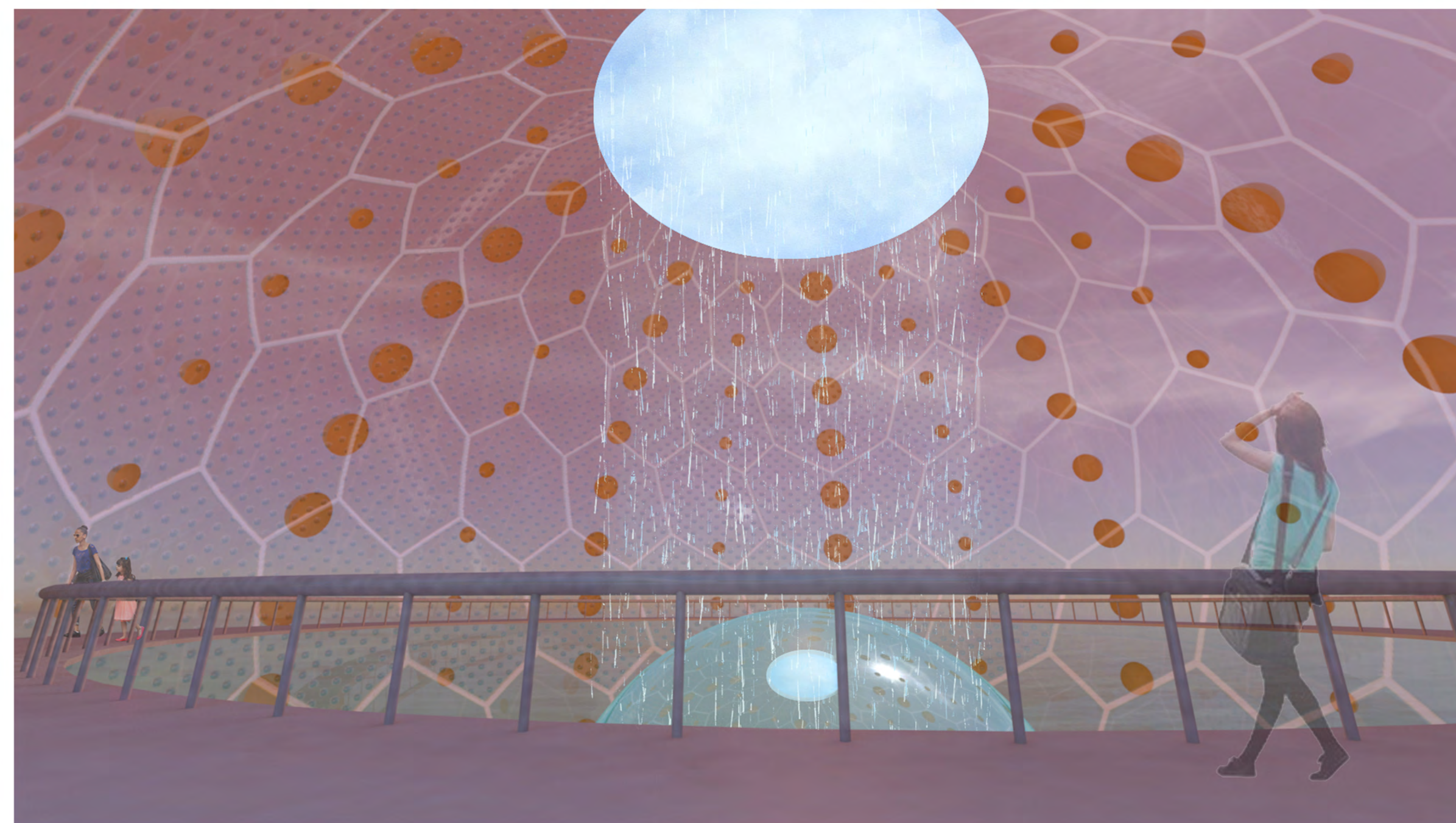


# A CELEBRATION OF WEATHER
