

THE PACIFIC POWER PALMS

Where Route 66 ends that is where PACIFIC POWER PALMS starts: an energetic initiative for the sea silhouette of Santa Monica, California. This landscape embodies the famous spirit of freedom tickled by the sunlight, palm-lined till infinity. Behind the beach line there is where the Pacific Ocean collides with the space of urban relaxation – the position of the 2016 Land Art Generator Initiative. PACIFIC POWER PALMS project combines the essence of the local landscape with the utilization of maritime power sources and possible outdoor fun action.

The seaside parallel to 3rd street promenade transfers the Los Angeles specific square pattern into a WODDEN jetty and reinterprets the most iconic symbol of the Californian coast – the palm tree – into a recognizable power production element. The groove of energy palms brings up a new kind public space where unexpected sojourn will be induced.
