



FOG CONDITIONS + PREVAILING WINDS ANALYSIS

Santa Monica has an average of 310 days of sunshine a year; however fog is a prevalent phenomenon throughout the year peaking in May and June, also known as “May Grey” and “June Gloom.” On certain years the Marine Layer extends to July and August , occasionally referred to as “No Sky July” and “Fogust.” MISTY(CAL) is oriented to take advantage of the prevailing South West wind direction as wind is a fundamental component to the fog collection process.
